

HEOP Photo Requirements

Each HEOP student is asked to submit a wallet style photo (approximately 3" x 4" in size) to the Academic Opportunity Programs Office. The photo does NOT have to be professionally done. Feel free to ask someone to take a photo of you or you can take a photo of yourself. In doing so, just remember the following:

1. The photo must be a headshot only. There should be no other things such as a person or animal in the photo with you. Objects are acceptable only when used as a prop (*as shown in photo #2 on your right*).
2. You should be looking/facing forward in the shot. Therefore, profile pictures are not acceptable. Additionally, you may not submit a cartoon sketch or a digitally altered/exaggerated photo of yourself. The photo must be considered proper, professional and respectable. We will not accept action shots, shots of you in a costume, a photo with you making a silly face, or any other comical, disrespectful, or unprofessional photo.

We have the right not to accept the photo you submit and will ask for another. If you do not have one to provide to us at this time, we have the right to take a photo of you upon your arrival and choose which one we feel fit to post in our office.

Remember, the photo you provide today will be the same photo that will remain posted in our office, as a log of our students, for the 4 – 5 years you are in HEOP at Fisher.
