Understanding Search Results

The “Capacity” column shows the number of seats reserved for the class. “Seats Avail.” shows the number of seats currently available for registration. Negative numbers in this column indicate that the class is overenrolled and registration is closed. Overenrolled classes are only available with permission from the instructor and/or department chair.

An introduction to electricity and magnetism, interference and diffraction of light, and some topics in quantum and atomic physics. Must also register for non-graded lab section.

PHYS132C-L1	P	20603	General Physics II Lab	0
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Click on a specific Course/Section (ex. PHYS 132-01) to view the course description and required prerequisites for the course.

This course description notes that credit for PHYS 131 with a grade of 'D-' or higher must be earned in order to register for PHYS 132. This course is also a liberal arts elective and a P4 Core class as illustrated under the "Attributes" heading.

The letter 'Y' indicates that the course may be taken at the same time as the course for which it is listed as a prerequisite. In this example, in order to take PHYS 132 you either must already have credit for MATH 122 *or* enroll in MATH 122 at the same time as PHYS 132 (co-requisite).
